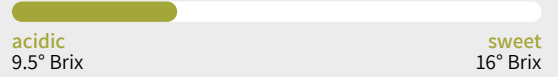

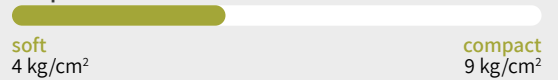
The sun child

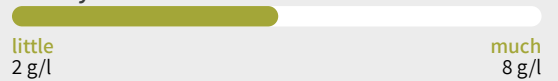

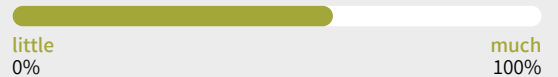
