

Passacrassana

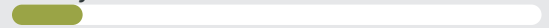
It is immediately recognizable by its long, woody stem, the base of which, like the calyx of the fruit, is often dusted with fine rust. The large fruit and round shape of the Passacrassana are also characteristic. Its thicker skin makes it very robust and resistant.

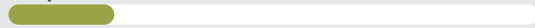

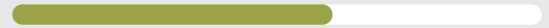
